HEALTH PLAN

The goal of the Early Learning Center's health plan is to keep children healthy and to prevent the spread of disease and infections. This is important to the children, families and staff at The Early Learning Center so that all members can maintain good health in order to attend school, families can keep their schedules and staff can report to work.

All families must report children's immunization records and completed health appraisals to the director and be kept on file. All immunizations are reported to the state of Michigan through the MICR website. Records are requested each school year and families must provide new documentation of updated health records. Any current matters must be reported to the director and these matters are then reported to the Washtenaw County Health Department by the director.

Since it is our goal to keep all members of the Early Learning Center healthy, we ask that you report any symptoms your child is experiencing (cough, runny nose, vomiting, rash, etc.) to the director. The director and parent will discuss the illness symptoms and make a determination together if it is okay for your child(ren) to attend school that day. All children must stay home if they have a fever and need to be 24 hours fever free before returning to school. If you know your child is ill, please keep him home and report the illness to the school. If you are unsure about a mild symptom such as a runny nose, please call the school director at 734-973-7722 or 248-767-5012 to discuss.
